TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS
IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED**

We, the undersigned, Citizens of Canada, draw the attention of the House to the following:

That the families of missing persons deserve to know the fate of their loved ones and DNA identification is a critical tool toward this goal;

That the federal government's review of DNA legislation does not conclude until 2005, and that this review will not address the issue of a missing person's DNA database;

That there are over 6,000 unidentified DNA samples obtained from crime scenes that may provide clues as to the fate of a missing person;

Therefore your petitioners call upon Parliament to enact legislation to create a DNA Missing Persons Database and Unidentified Human Remains Database, which would link with the existing National DNA databank and assist in determining the fate of missing persons;
